

### Message from Fr John

As announced at Masses over the weekend of 24/25 March, the Bishop has asked me to take up a new appointment at St Mary's, Horwich. It is a slightly smaller parish than here but with only one primary school and one secondary school. I will also have an Assistant Priest to cover a lot of the parish work. What is more, it is a lot closer to my office in Salford Cathedral Centre and nearer to Wardley Hall. It is only right that another priest is appointed who can give you all the care and attention that you deserve.

I will have my last Masses here over the weekend of 8<sup>th</sup> April before going on holiday from the 13 – 20 April. Fr Anthony McLaughlin will be here over the weekend 15 April. I will be clearing from the Presbytery 23 – 27 April.

I have done almost 400 Baptisms, 200 Confirmations, 70 Weddings and over 250 Funerals. So I have got to know many of you during very joyful and sad times, and it has been a privilege to walk with you.


Having spent 10 years here, after my return to the diocese, I have many great memories and experiences of the people of Oswaldtwistle and Accrington who have given me tremendous support and encouragement, accepted my weaknesses and given me strength. The work that I have been able to do was founded on the work of Fr Patrick Bourke, and I am sure that you will give the same support to **Fr Sean O'Brien** who is replacing me. I would like to say that Fr Sean is a priest that has been ordained for over 7 years. He is, like Fr Gavin Landers and myself, a Stretfordian. I truly believe that he will bring different charisms to the parish and journey with you, as a good shepherd does, on your journey. He will bring a great spirituality to the parish. I wish you all well, and if I have upset anyone during my time here I humbly ask forgiveness.

I thank you for all the support you have all given me in the way you have been "Ambassadors for Christ". We have had some fantastic times together.

### The Community Project

We are now well on our way with raising money to be able to welcome into our community family from Syria. It is important that we keep up our commitment. For those who wish to make a small monthly donation for a fixed period by standing order, please speak with David Neville. Thank you for all who have expressed support and we will keep you informed. So far, we have raised approximately £3,000 in a relatively short period, we need to raise a total of £9000 in order to receive match funding from the Salford Dioceses and Caritas, however £4000 will enable us to formally register our application with the Home Office. This month we will be having a charity fundraiser at Franco's Restaurant on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> April at 7pm. We should have a maximum of 40 places and will charge £15 per head for a three-course meal.
